

VCAL Uniform Policy 2017

Students are required to wear full school uniform

Clothing

- All students are expected to wear full school uniform daily, including to and from school and on most excursions.
- Uniform items are required to be in good condition; clothes need to be freshly laundered and items with holes/tears need to be repaired or replaced.
- Students may not wear additional items that are not school uniform. This includes items such as hoodies, coloured t-shirts, colourful scarves, hats/caps and runners.
- For PE and Sport classes in the morning, students may come to school in sport attire but must bring their full school uniform to change into at lunch time. For PE and Sport classes in the afternoon, students must come to school in full school uniform but bring sport attire to change into at lunch time. Only students engaged in PE and Sport classes in the afternoon may go home in their sport attire. If a student has purchased the official Hume Central sports uniform, they are entitled to wear this the whole day of sports programs.

Jewellery

- Simple jewellery only. Eg studs, sleepers, single bracelets, etc
- Facial piercing must be kept to a minimum and only jewellery that sits flush to the face is allowed. Students who wear protruding facial jewellery will be required to remove it.

Responsibilities

Students

- Any student, who is unable to wear full school uniform on any day, requires a written note from a parent/guardian, outlining a reasonable explanation. Parents will be contacted to bring uniform to the school for students who repeatedly arrive out of uniform.

Staff

- All staff will be responsible to address students who are not in full school uniform.

Procedure

For students who are wearing items that are not part of school uniform:

- Students will be asked to remove the item and hand it to the teacher.

First offence: The item will be confiscated until the end of the day.

Second offence: The item will be confiscated until the end of the week.

Third offence: The item will be confiscated. A parent/carer will be required to collect the item.
