



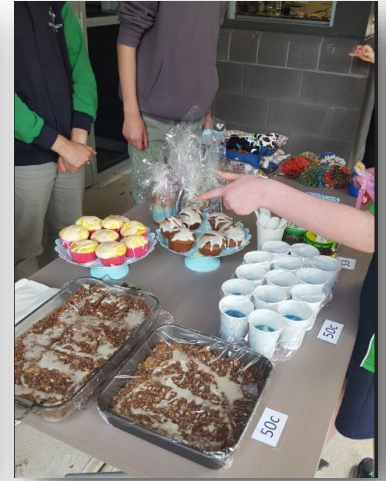

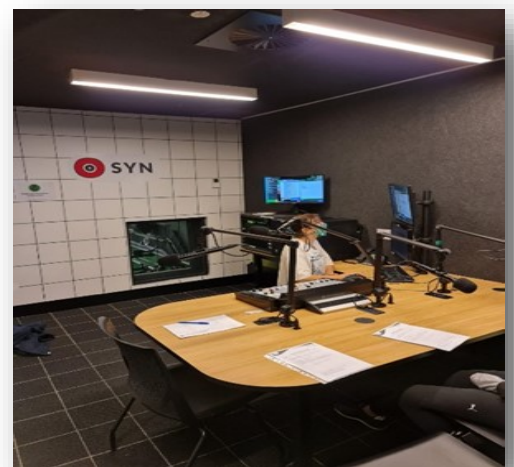


Creative Workers in Schools
