## VCAL Horticulture

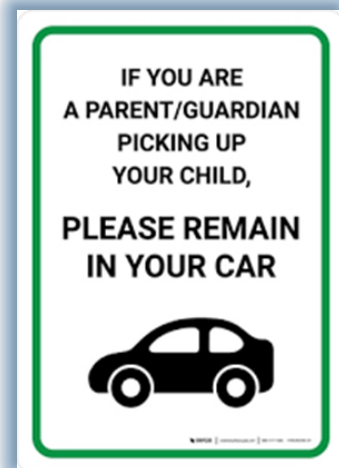
