WHAT IS FACEBOOK? Facebook is a social media service that lets you create a page about yourself, an organisation or group. You can add friends, write on people's pages, share photos and videos including live videos.

IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMIND YOUR CHILD:

- No one under 13 years of age is allowed to use Facebook.
- Only accept friend requests from people you know in real life.
- Think before you post.
- You can block someone to unfriend them and prevent them from starting conversations with you or seeing things that you post on your profile.

Sometimes the best way to learn what apps your children are using is to download them and practice using them yourself! Ask your child/ children to teach you!
