## The Haunting of Hume Manor

VCAL students enrolled in the Certificate II in Creative Industries have had a rough year trying to put on a play. Our Western feature, 'Doom Valley', had to be postponed to 2021, so this term we've been working on a shorter, more simple piece so that the students have something to perform in front of an audience.

The piece is called 'The Haunting of Hume Manor', and is performed in the style of 'poor theatre'. This means that students perform without the use of any stagecraft elements, such as; props, set pieces, sound effects or lighting. It is quite physically demanding, as the actors are required to make all of the sound effects with their own voices while they frequently transform character and even perform as inanimate objects, such as a grandfather clock. The Creative Industries class will perform the piece outdoors for the students on the Koroit Ave campus this November.
