TARGET VOCABULARY:

Verbs: wash, clean, play, eat, cook, sleep, wear, put

Nouns: couch, TV, cup, clothes, fridge, oven, ball, bike, pillow, blanket, couch, bath, ironing board, microwave, shampoo, soccer ball, dirty, washing machine, washing powder, toys, mirror, wardrobe, shoes, bike, table, shower, toilet

Concepts: household vocabulary, function

HOW TO PLAY:

- Name all the different household items
- Name all the different rooms in the house
- Sort all the household items into the room where you would find them
- Talk about what the items are used for
- Talk about why you would find it in this room

WHEN PLAYING WITH THE CARDS USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

- “What do we put in a fridge?”
- “Where does a bed go?”
- “Can you find the couch?”
- “The washing machine goes in the laundry.”
- “What else can we find in the kitchen?”
- “What things are in your bedroom?”
- “The oven is really hot. We use it to cook things.”
- “What can we do in the backyard?”

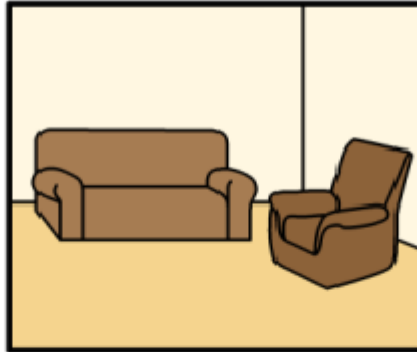
NOTE:

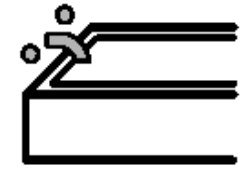

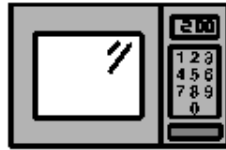

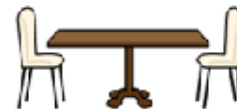
