## SRC

Since the Student Representative Council (SRC) was introduced in 2018 it has established itself as an integral program that recognises the importance of student voice within the Hume Valley School community.

Elected student members have the opportunity to represent the student body, advocate for the school, and further develop their leadership skills. The SRC is made up of three committees: Primary Committee (Juniors, Primaries and Middles), Secondary Committee (Secondaries and Seniors) and the Senior Committee (PreCAL and VCAL).

After a delayed start due to COVID restrictions the SRC program began in Term 3. The initial focus has been to establish the community and function of the SRC. The committees have already contributed to discussion about the remote learning experience and future planning for events and student initiatives.
