## TARGET VOCABULARY:

**Verbs:** circle, run, grow, taste, feel, eat

**Adjectives:** taller, shorter, younger, older, louder, quieter, harder, softer, faster, slower, sweeter, saltier, colder, bigger, smaller

**Concepts:** comparison, differences

## HOW TO PLAY:

- Print off the worksheet below
- Go through all the pictures and name them
- Read the instructions and complete the worksheet
- Let your child try first. They might need you to give them some clues
- Try to think of your own examples when completing the worksheet e.g what else is smaller than an elephant?

## WHEN COMPLETING THIS WORKSHEET USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

- "Is a plane louder than a car?"
- "That's right, the boy is younger"
- "What is this called? It's a feather!"
- "Where do we find feathers?"
- "This boy is younger. Am I older or younger than you?"
- "Is an elephant big or small? That's right, so the elephant is **bigger** than the mouse!"
- "What else is bigger than a mouse? What is smaller?"
- "Can you think of something else that is fast?"

## NOTE:

- You can extend this game by thinking of other examples when doing the worksheet e.g. "what else is bigger than a mouse? What is smaller?"
- You can make this activity fun by including examples that are relevant to your child's everyday life e.g. "is mum older or younger than you?"
