## WORDS TO USE:

**Verbs:** choose, put, match

**Nouns:** swings, TV, bed, tree, sun, lamp, slide, couch, microwave, barbeque, bath, pool

**Concepts:** inside/outside

## HOW TO PLAY:

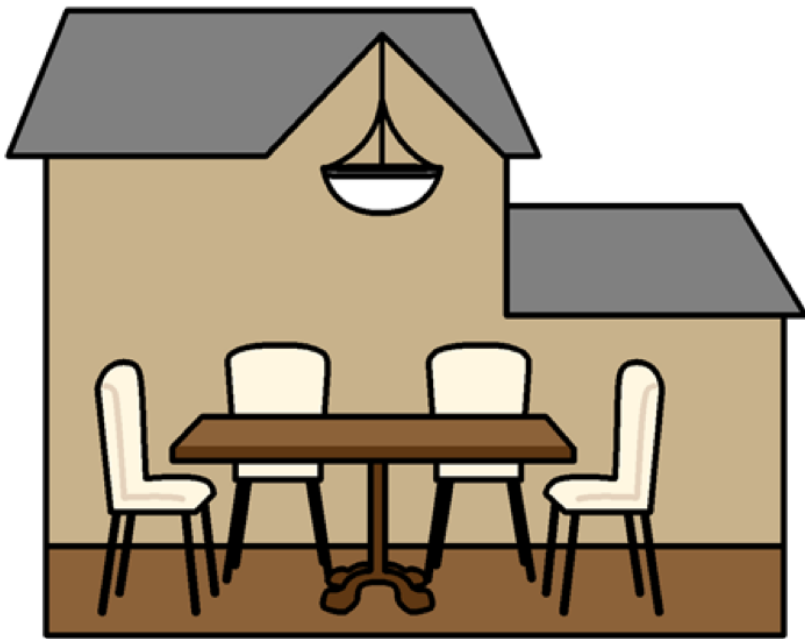
- Print the pictures on the next page and cut them out.
- Put the inside/outside pictures on the table or on the floor.
- Choose a small picture card and place it on or under the *inside* or *outside* card.
- Talk about the objects and where they belong e.g. "A bath belongs inside the house", "The sun is outside".

## USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

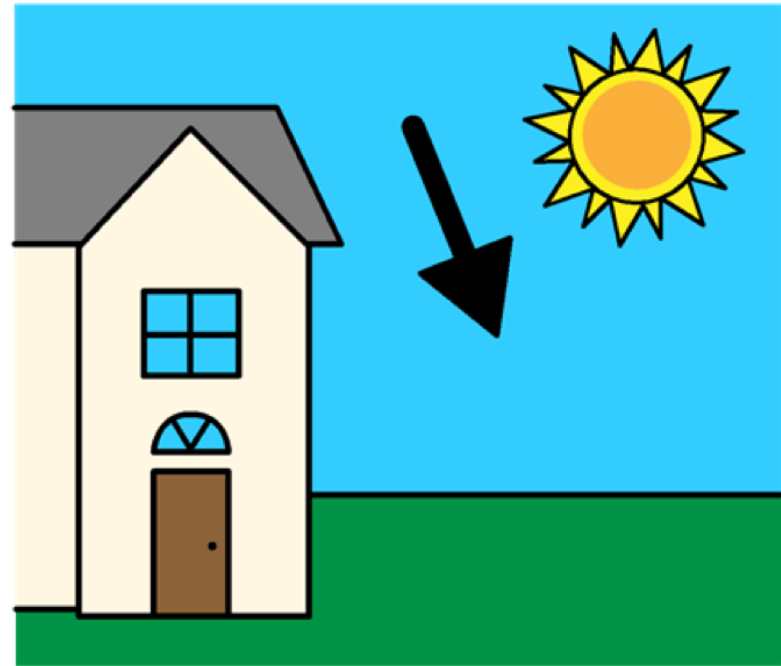
- "Choose a picture"
- "What did you choose?"
- "A slide! Does a slide belong inside or outside?"
- "I chose a couch. Where does a couch belong?"
- "A barbeque belongs outside. Where does a barbeque belong?"
- "Look! The sun! What colour is the sun? *Pause*. Does it belong inside or outside?"
- "Great matching! A pool belongs outside."

## NOTE:

- You can play hide and seek with the cards before sorting them.
- Continue playing this game throughout the week by talking about things in your house and backyard and whether they belong inside or outside.

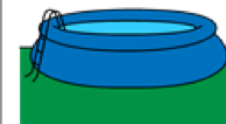
