HOW TO PLAY:

- Click on this link:

- Press the space bar to see the answer
- Press the space bar again to see the next question
- Repeat until the questions are finished

- "What do you drive?"
- "Do you sit on an apple? No, that's silly"
- "That's right, you wear a hat and socks."
- "I love how you are trying so hard"
- "Let's go to the next page to see if we were right."
- "You think we use an oven to cook. So do I."
