WE ARE PRACTISING:

- Identifying things that are the *same* and *different*.

HOW TO PLAY:

- Click on this link: https://docs.google.com/presentation/d/1tQk_3eim5_kLHk2GfkyTT-8EDPCGGeegvIYFjGrErO4/edit?usp=sharing
- Click on 'present' in the top right corner of the page
- Press the space bar to go to the next page
- Ask your child the question, like "Are these pictures the same or different?" Point to the same and different pictures below as you say it.
- Your child can answer by pointing to the *same* or *different* picture or using their words.
- Press the space bar to see the answer.
- Press the space bar again to see the next question.
- Repeat until the questions are finished.

USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE

- "These eyes are blue, and these eyes are brown. They are different."
- "These dogs are the same."
- "Well done- they are different."
- "I love how you are trying so hard"
- "Let's go to the next page to see if we were right."
