

Animal Guessing Game

WORDS TO USE:

Verbs: swim, run, walk, fly, hop, climb, live

Nouns: animal names, zoo, farm, ocean, river, pond, sky, tree, jungle

Adjectives: soft, fluffy, rough, spiky, smooth, bumpy, hard

Concepts: same/different

HOW TO PLAY:

- Name the animals on the cards
- You can cut out the pictures to make cards or leave the sheet as it is
- One person picks an animal and doesn't show/tell the other person what animal they have
- The person with no card has to ask questions to help them guess what animal it is
- The person with the card can give clues
- Take it in turns to be the person guessing

You might find it helpful to use the question prompts for you and your child.

USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

- "What colour is the animal?"
- "Where does it live?"
- "What sound does it make?"
- "This animal has stripes"
- "It lives in the ocean. What animal could it be?"
- "This one is a pig. Pigs go oink oink"
- "Can you find the shark?"

NOTE:

- You can use toy animals instead of picture cards if you have them
