

Colour Vocabulary – Treasure Hunt

TARGET VOCABULARY:

Verbs: find, look, bring, point, search

Nouns: colours – blue, red, green, yellow, purple, black, white, orange, pink, grey

Concepts: colours, following directions

HOW TO PLAY:

- Ask your child to tell you what the colours are on the cards below to check they understand.
- Tell your child you are going to do a treasure hunt in the house to find colours.
- Say “find something blue”
 - Point to the *find* picture, then the *blue* picture.

WHEN PLAYING , USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

- “What colour is this?”
- “Show me red”
- “Point to green”
- “That’s right, the ball is blue!”
- “Great searching- you found a pink cushion”
- “Green is my favourite colour.”
- “What colours do you like?”
- “I like how you are doing great listening.”

NOTE:

- You can swap with your child and get them to ask you to find colours around the house.
