Nouns: police station, pool, park, zoo, hospital, supermarket, beach, library, Kmart

Concepts: community locations

HOW TO PLAY:

- Use the cards below to do this activity
- Name all the different community locations
- Sort all the people and things into the places where you would find them
- Talk about:
 - Why does it belong there?
 - What else could you find there?
 - Who works there?
 - Why do you go there?

WHEN PLAYING WITH THE CARDS USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE:

- “Why do we go to the hospital?”
- “Who works at a police station?”
- “Can you find the zoo?”
- “What things do we do at the park?”
- “Where does the monkey go?”
- “The fish needs water to swim”
- “This is a library. We need to be quiet in the library”
- “What is this called? That’s right, it’s a pool!”
