WORDS TO USE:

Verbs: colour

Nouns: farm, elephant, pig, horse, cow, chicken, sheep, whale, duck, snake

HOW TO PLAY:

- Print the next page.
- Choose an animal to talk about.
- Ask your child “Does this animal live on a farm?”
- Colour in all the animals that live on a farm.

USE SENTENCES LIKE THESE

- “What animal is this?”
- “It’s a cow. Does a cow live on a farm?”
- “Let’s colour in the chicken because it lives on a farm.”
- “Where does a horse live?”
- “That’s right! A sheep does live on the farm. Colour it in.”
- “Good try. An elephant lives in the zoo or in Africa. It does not live on a farm.”
- “A whale lives in the ocean. It does not live on the farm.”
- “What noise does a duck make?”
- “Who makes this noise? *Oink Oink!* That’s right a pig. Does a pig live on a farm?”

NOTE:

- If you have play doh at home, you can try to make some of the farm animals with it.
